OVERVIEW:

Develop and sustain connections with organizations that produce, process and/or distribute food. Develop and sustain connections with non-profit organizations (NPOs) that participate in the charitable distribution of food for the purpose of safely and efficiently directing excess edible food from donor to recipient NPO for distribution to those experiencing food insecurity. Facilitate the implementation of Abound's 'food care' initiatives. Ensure partners and stakeholders understand the donation/distribution process. Assist food donors with program implementation. Develop trust in the Abound Food Care brand. Collaborate with the sales team to provide access to bulk purchasing programs.

Conduct outreach to NPOs

- Guide and support nonprofit organizations on elements of a safe food recovery program
- Collect required data from NPOs.
- Provide information to NPOs about Abound Food Care's Enhanced Procurement program.

Support execution of jurisdiction contracts

- Support timely completion of contract deliverables, including but not limited to surveys, email engagement, in person visits and outreach calls to obtain required data.
- Engage with food donors, NPOs, and other stakeholders within a jurisdiction



 Utilize and capture data in appropriate software programs. Produce written reports, adhering to committed timelines, for clients

Support stakeholder interactions

- Give presentations to build clientele and prospective interest in working with Abound Food Care
- Engage in conversation with prospective clients via phone, email or in-person meetings Promote Abound Food Care solutions to new and existing clients to:
- Maintain working knowledge of all Abound Food Care programs, initiatives and resources.
- Initiate interactions where opportunities to promote Abound Food Care solutions arise
